"Panic on Pikes Peak", written by local playwright William Clifton, is a slap-stick, crazy fun 1930's melodrama set on the top of Pikes Peak at radio station KOZY. The station owner, Mr. Bing Crosley, his daughter Connie Crosley, and mild mannered sound effects man Andy Anderson have to become very creative when their radio staff is tricked, by the evil Bachman Turner, into leaving for high paying jobs in California. The live radio program begins in 30 seconds – whatever will they do!? Tune in to find out whether Mr. Turner and his alluring sidekick Foxy Hart will manage to murder Mr. Crosley, steal the money and take over the station, or earn a long stint in the jail house! This production is directed by Noah Hensley with musical direction by Bruce Littrell, Mark Arnest and Michael Brown. The cast includes Rebekah Ratterree, Jacob Cantor, Cheyenne York, Jacob Ashman, Mitchell Newman, and Michael Brown on piano.

Following the melodrama is a fun-filled sing-a-long intermission, performed by the beautiful and talented Camille Henry. Intermission gives the audience an opportunity to warm-up their vocal cords on some old standards, celebrate birthdays and anniversaries, or just take a break.

Then the cast returns to perform a 1980s Olio review with music, dance and comedy from that ever popular decade. As always, audience participation makes for a different show every night that has something for all ages. Musical direction is by Bruce Littrell, Mark Arnest and Michael Brown with choreography by Brittani Janish and Daisya Downen. Costumes and wigs by Leah Montgomery and Aaron Graves. Backstage tech is by Tom Woodruff.
